

Earth Day March for Science, Chicago, Time and location TBD.


Tuesday April 25th:



The Democratic Candidates for Downers Grove Township are to be commended for representing us well on April 4. This was

a low turnout election with only 18.6% of the vote. While the outcome of the election was not what we had hoped to see, there is good news in the numbers.

The candidates generated at least 2,000 more votes per candidate than in either of the two previous elections. 
